# 2nd Proposal: a 3-button solution



### **Check Button:**

- always enabled if an action panel has the focus, ٠
- is optional, checks are performed when necessary, •
- has three visible states: •





- Ø
- Checked with errors Check and



- Checked without errors, which includes warnings or info
- clicking on the Check button always performs all the tests except the send-specific ones,
- shows Dialog "ValidationResult" if Errors, Warnings or Info found ٠
- shows always "Unchecked" when opening a dossier, thus forcing a full • test before sending this.

## **Print Button:**

- always enabled if an action panel has the focus
- can be used independent from any state of check
- performs a print on the default printer:
  - o a final print if not combined action or search action
  - o a draft print if combined action or search action
- always allows to select the forms to print in a print select dialog
- doesn't change any status if printing was done.

## **Print & Send Button**

- enabled if
  - o an action has the focus AND
  - o this action is unchecked or is error-free;
- shows if this action has been sent successfully Print and Send
- all the checks not yet performed are executed now. The same check on unchanged actions is avoided;
- if any errors arise during send check, neither print nor send are performed;
- if additional warnings or infos come up during the send check the examiner can decide whether to continue or cancel the process;
- if the check is done without any errors, warnings or infos, the send process starts immediately (without prior confirmation);
- simple action only (not search report): after successful send, the examiner can select the forms to print in a print select dialog. He can also decide not to print anything;
- the examiner always gets a confirmation in a message box after print and send, maybe successful or not.

## Modifying data of an action

• requires new check and send, thus removes the check marks from all the

buttons:

Effect on the status of an action (1st draft of this, for discussion): From the examiner's point of view the status of an action can be

- o not sent (former: active, printed, checked, ready)
- sent (former: sent-not-coded, sent)
- read-only (former: archived, dispatched)
- o maybe special: being processed, purged, reactivated
